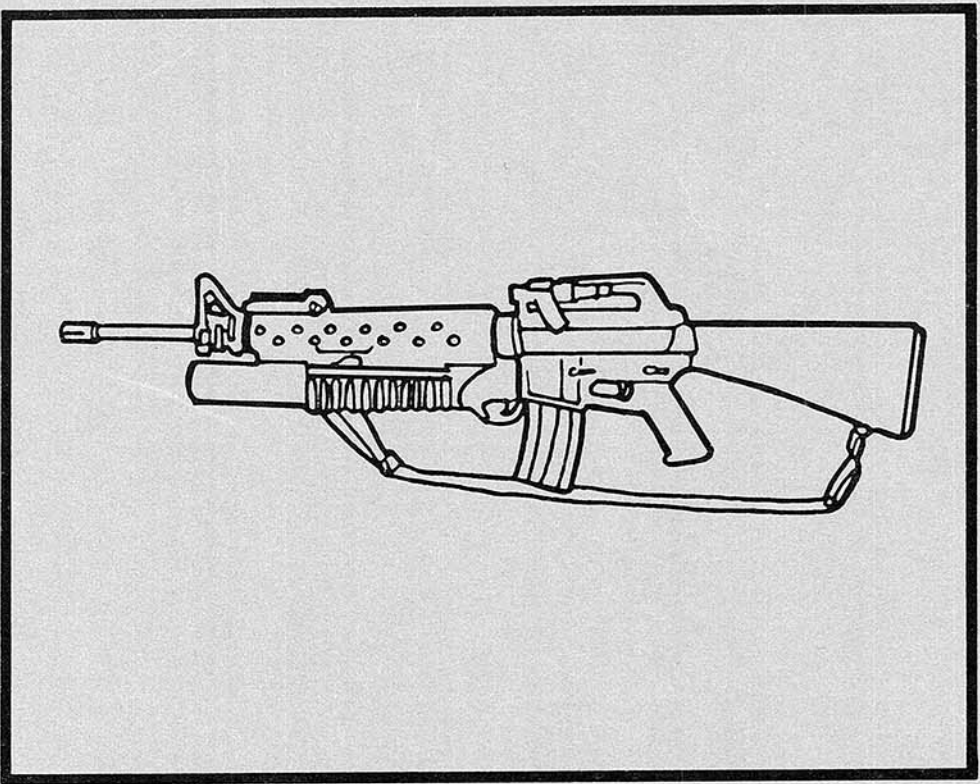

STUDENT INSTRUCTIONS

Before taking this lesson, complete TEC Lesson No. 551-101-8362-A, "Preventive Maintenance on the M203 Grenade Launcher."

- Take the pretest. If you pass the pretest, you need not take this lesson.
- Insure that you have all material, equipment, or personnel required to complete this lesson.
- Read this lesson. Practice each step in the lesson until you can do it without looking at the book.
- Take the posttest. If you do not pass, read the lesson again and repeat the test.
- It is very important that you read every step in this lesson. Do not skip around and do the steps out of order. You could hurt yourself or harm the equipment. Do not do anything that is not explained in the lesson booklet, and observed all safety warnings. Safety warnings are printed in red. These are cautions or warnings you must observe so that you do not injure yourself or harm the equipment.
- Keep track of all dummy rounds. Keep them locked in your tool kit or some other location separate from live ammunition.
- Always clear any weapon before you work on it.
- Read all CAUTIONS printed in red BEFORE doing the next step.
- Be extra careful when working with springs that can fly out. Wear safety goggles.
- Do not write on this lesson booklet

SUPERVISOR INSTRUCTIONS

- Insure that the student has completed the prerequisites listed above.
- Insure that the student has all material, equipment, or personnel required to complete this lesson.
- This lesson is self-teaching and self-paced. The soldier will learn the task by reading and doing the steps in the lesson. He can use as much time as needed, within reasonable limits, to learn the task.

- As a supervisor, you should be familiar with the lesson material so you can answer questions, score tests, and insure that all safety precautions and warnings are followed.
- Although this is a self-teaching program, it may be necessary for you to assist the soldier if he has difficulties. Everything the soldier needs to know to pass the test is in this booklet. When a soldier does not understand a step, it is usually because he is going too fast and skips a step. Reading the section again will often solve the problem. Occasionally, a soldier will not understand the whole lesson. If you are familiar with the weapon, you may explain the steps; or, if you will read the lesson yourself, you should be able to explain it to the soldier. If the weapon becomes jammed or is disassembled beyond organizational level, and neither you nor the soldier can remedy the problem, take it to direct support maintenance for repair.
- Allow the student to read the lesson and practice the task before testing.
- Follow set-up and scoring instructions for the test.
- Do not aid the soldier in taking the test.
- Observe the soldier's performance in the pretest/posttest.
- Score each answer as GO/NO GO. The correct answers are on the last page of this lesson booklet.
- Be sure the soldier completes the task within the required time limit.

Service Upon Receipt of Materiel for the M203 Grenade Launcher

General Information

This pretest/posttest covers the service performed upon receipt of materiel for the M203 grenade launcher. In order to pass the test, the soldier must answer the 5 questions correctly within 15 minutes. If he fails the test, the lesson must be repeated and the test retaken. The following items must be available for the soldier's use during the test:

Pencils
Lesson booklet
Paper

The scorer must have a watch, a pen or pencil, paper and the answers to pretest/posttest located on the last page of this lesson.

Test Instructions:

Read aloud the test instructions to the soldier, and begin timing his performance. Do not let the soldier continue past the time limit. 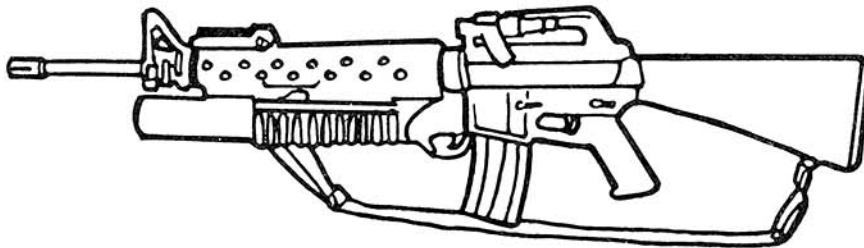

INTRODUCTION:

This is TEC Lesson No. 551-101-8363-A, "Service Upon Receipt of Materiel for the M203 Grenade Launcher." This lesson will show you how to perform service upon receipt of an M203 grenade launcher.

EQUIPMENT/MATERIALS REQUIRED:

Items listed in Student/Supervisor Instructions on page i.

PERFORM SERVICE UPON RECEIPT OF MATERIEL

As the unit armorer, you must make sure each new or reconditioned weapon has its parts and special equipment, and is in good condition upon receipt. To do this, you must perform all the steps in Table 2-1, of TM 9-1010-221-24. If during the performance of these steps you identify any missing or broken parts, you must report them to your supervisor. If you are authorized to replace a broken or missing part, order the part.

Turn to Table 2-1, Service Upon Receipt of Materiel, in TM 9-1010-221-24. Read all the steps in that table and use it to answer the self-evaluation questions.
