# INSTRUCTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS REGARDING THE TURN-IN, TO DEPOT, OF RIFLES, 5.56-MM, M16 AND M16A1 (XM16E1)

Headquarters, Department of the Army, Washington, D.C.

21 March 1967

**1. Purpose.** This bulletin provides instructions and imposes restrictions relative to turn-in of Rifle, 5.56-MM, M16 or M16A1 (XM16E1), by posts, camps, or stations.

**2. Procedure.** *a. Unserviceable Weapons (Beyond the Capability of the Post, Camp, or Station to Repair).* This category of condition is limited to those weapons with damaged lower receivers or severe loss of anodized surface finishes. Restrictions are based on the criteria that all components for these weapons (with the exception of the lower receiver) are authorized for replacement at field support maintenance level. Weapons properly classified in this condition code will be reported, in accordance with AR 755-1, to the Commanding General, U.S. Army Weapons Command, Attn: National Inventory Control Point, Rock Island Arsenal, Rock Island, Ill. 61201 for disposition instructions. Depots will not accept unserviceable M16 or M16A1 (XM16E1) Rifles turned in by posts, camps, or stations.

*b. Serviceable Weapons.* This category is limited to weapons generated as excess to post, camp, or station allowances. These weapons will be reported, in accordance with AR 755-1, to the Commanding General, U.S. Army Weapons Command, Attn: National Inventory Control Point, Rock Island Arsenal, Rock Island, Ill. 61201 for disposition. Weapons reported and directed for turn-in under this condition code must be in good repair and acceptable for reissue without inspection or repair.

**3. Disposition.** The National Inventory Control Point, Headquarters, U.S. Army Weapons Command will furnish disposal or shipping instructions.

**4. Reporting of Bulletin Improvements.** Use DA Form 2028 (Recommended Changes to DA Publications) for reporting errors, omissions, and recommendations for improvement and forward direct to the Commanding General, U.S. Army Weapons Command, ATTN: AMSWE-SMM-P, Rock Island Arsenal, Rock Island, Ill. 61201.
